



## **Coding Competition**





On Tuesday, Joshua, Ethan A, Robin and myself went to The Centre for Computing History, in Cambridge, for a 'Micro Bit Coding Challenge' for Year 6 pupils. The aim of the competition was to get a buggy around a small racetrack using 2 micro bits and a buggy. We began by setting up the radio to direct our buggy. Then, we set the sensor to detect the line enabling the buggy to turn in a set direction. Following this we had to code the buggy; we coded the buggy to try to turn in a multitude of directions to ensure it got around the obstacle. We came first in our group for this — our buggy took 53.4 seconds! Overall, we found it a challenging yet really exciting day.
